Auction Information

When you arrive at the Craneway Pavilion on April 10, you will receive a unique bidder number to use for both the Silent and Live auctions. There are several different ways to purchase auction items:

- **No-Bid Purchases** – No-bid purchases are items that are sold for a fixed price. Simply write your bidder number on the bid sheet. Purchasing continues until all slots are filled, on a first-come, first-served basis.
- **Silent Auction Bidding** – The Silent Auction opens at 5:30 pm. To bid on a silent auction item, simply enter your bidder number and the amount of your bid on the bid sheet for that particular item. Starting bids and minimum increases are noted on each bid sheet.
- **Live Auction Bidding** – At the event, you will receive a “bidder paddle” with your unique bid number on it. To bid, simply raise your bidding paddle above your head at the desired price and receive acknowledgment from the auctioneer. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer will be the purchaser. If you win the item, a volunteer will ask for your signature to confirm your winning bid. Payment must be received the night of the Auction.
- **Absentee Bidding** – If you are unable to attend the auction but want to bid on an item, you may place an absentee bid. Absentee bids must be received by noon on Friday, April 9, 2010, and must include a valid credit card number. In the event of identical bids, the earliest bid received will take precedence. The highest absentee bid will be entered as the initial bid at the beginning of the auction.
- **Proxy Bidding** – If you prefer, you may ask a friend who will be attending the auction to bid on your behalf. Please note that your proxy bidder will be responsible to pay for and remove any items you successfully bid on that night; you will not be billed later.

- **Group Bidding** – For large items and events, group bidding is encouraged. In advance of the Auction, each group should designate an authorized bidder who will bid on behalf of all group members.

Checking Out and Claiming Your Winnings

Check-out will begin five minutes after the live auction ends. All winning bids will be tabulated based on bidder number. At check-out, you will receive an itemized invoice of all purchases. Please arrange payment in full by check, Visa, MasterCard, or cash. All physical items should be removed from the Craneway Pavilion on the night of the auction, unless you sign up for Special Delivery (see below).

Gift certificates and other non-physical items can be collected at your child's campus beginning, Wednesday, April 14. Bidders who are not current TBS parents will have their winning items (gift certificates and non-physical items) mailed to them the week of April 12.

Winning bids that are not paid for the night of the event may be disqualified at the discretion of the Auction Committee. Those items may then be sold to the next highest bidder.

Express Check-out

With Express Check-out, you can speed right through check-out. Just sign up for Express Check-out when you arrive, and provide a credit card authorization or blank check. We will do our best to have your winning items ready for you at check-out, we'll handle the paperwork, and you'll zip through the queue.

Special Delivery

Would you like our convenient delivery service to deliver your winning items? Sign up for Special Delivery, and for a fee (\$40) you can avoid check-out altogether. Your items will be delivered to your door at a later time, to be arranged. You can sign up for Special Delivery when you check in.

Auction Information, cont'd

Please be advised: Payment must be made in full prior to the conclusion of the evening. Payment may be made in cash, with Visa or MasterCard, or by check payable to TBSPA.

Unless otherwise specified, the following conditions apply to all items:

- **All sales are final.** No exchanges or refunds are possible.
- **All items are sold “as is.”** Unless otherwise noted, items and services are good for one year and must be used by April 10, 2011. Neither the TBS Parents Association, The Berkeley School, nor the Auction Committee can guarantee any purchase.
- **Unless specified, dates and times are to be arranged at the mutual convenience of the donor and buyer.** Buyers are responsible for making arrangements with the contact person for all services, vacations, trips, and hotel stays in advance, checking expiration dates on contracts and/or gift certificates, and retaining the original paperwork until the donation has been redeemed.
- **The Auction Committee’s intent is to accurately describe all catalog items with the information provided by our generous donors.** Catalog descriptions of items include an estimated fair market value. The TBS Parents Association does not appraise or estimate the fair market value of auction items. Donors have furnished all statements of value appearing in the catalog. All values are estimates only and are not guaranteed by TBS Parents Association or The Berkeley School.
- **By his/her purchase, the buyer waives any claim for liability against The Berkeley School or its employees, the Auction volunteers, the Auctioneer, or the donor of the property or services.** Neither The Berkeley School, TBSPA, the Auctioneer, nor the donor is responsible for any

personal injuries or damages to property that may result from the use of property or services sold.

- **Getaways** – Resort and family properties are not available to student groups or minors unaccompanied by adults. Commercial vacations and accommodations require advance reservations; offer is good on a space-available basis; unless otherwise noted, meals, alcoholic beverages, taxes, gratuities, and transportation are not included.

Auction purchases are tax-deductible only to the extent that the amount paid for an item exceeds the fair market value of that item. Further, the Internal Revenue Service now requires charitable organizations to provide receipts listing the fair market value of each item. At the

Auction and in the week to follow, you will be provided with a receipt that will list both the fair market value of each item purchased and the amount you paid for each item. Please save this receipt for your records in order to substantiate any income tax deductions you may take as a result of your Auction purchases. Buyers and donors should consult with their tax advisers for definite advice concerning deductibility.

“RAISE YOUR PADDLE”

“Raise Your Paddle” is an opportunity for everyone to participate in a live auction while helping to support a critical TBS program. Here’s what Head of School Mitch Bostian says about good educational technology.

What is “good educational technology”? Good technology — which is often “sunk below the surface” of the classroom — is hardware, software, and platforms (devices and programs) that allow students to access information, explore areas of knowledge and human experience, and demonstrate their thinking, learning, and understanding.

What could this look like at TBS? Imagine walking into a classroom and encountering a learning environment suffused with images of student work — not just finished copies and final drafts, but “snapshots” of different steps in the process — the “sausage making” along with the sausage, or, more poetically, the dancers AND the dance.

Imagine watching students gather around images and video of work that they’ve done — process as well as product — and reflecting deeply.

Imagine logging onto your child’s classroom blog and, through words and images, getting the “story behind the story” — the learning background that led to the detailed watershed diagram that now hangs on the refrigerator. You knew that your student had studied watersheds; now, you can see HOW that learning developed, just as your student’s teacher could.

Imagine seeing your eighth-grade student access a real-time video, with voiceover, that illustrates how to solve a quadratic equation by factoring — a video that was made in class, that day, and narrated by the teacher and classmates. Imagine listening to a student-produced podcast that explores connections between California explorers and the students’ experiences in California today, complete with interviews, sound effects, and accurate historical information.

Imagine being able to capture more of the dynamic thinking and learning processes that underlie all deep understanding, and that go far beyond test scores and grades. We do.

What exactly do you mean and how much will this cost? As a school, we believe that teachers are the most important contributors to a child's learning; however, good technology is an important tool. Here are some tools we know will make a difference at TBS:

- Digital cameras (\$80 each – one per classroom)
- Flip cameras (\$150 each –one per classroom)
- Scanners for archiving/documenting student work (\$350 each, one per classroom)
- Color printers (\$250 each)
- USB Headsets (for recording ideas, for podcasts, etc.) (\$50 each)
- VoiceThread subscription (a web-based platform that allows teachers to upload images, videos, and other artifacts for student comments and questions. Just \$300 per year will provide every student and every teacher at TBS with an account.)
- Jing Pro subscription — software that allows teachers and students to record what's happening on their computer screens, with voiceover, and instantly archive it as a video file. If a teacher wants to show students how to solve a math equation in real time, in a form that can be revisited as many times as needed, Jing will record it. If teachers want to have students explain why they chose to edit an essay in a certain way, Jing can record their thoughts as they make the changes onscreen. (\$14.95 per account, per year).
- Sound recorders for students to record podcasts, teachers to record students working in groups and individually. (\$60 each, two per classroom)
- Digital projectors (to save paper and project student work) (\$500 and up, one per classroom)
- Interactive whiteboards, such the eno Polyvision, which also functions as a “regular” whiteboard. SmartBoards are only the beginning! (\$1,000 each, one per classroom at the 1310 campus)
- Netbooks (computers that are built solely to connect to the internet, not to store data.) Small, light, economical, easy to use, and hard to break. (\$250-\$300 each)
- MacBook computers, with iMovie, GarageBand, Keynote, Numbers, and other software that allows students to communicate ideas and concepts clearly and creatively, using multiple forms of media (\$1,000 for a MacBook, \$1,300 for a MacBook Pro)
