

Basketball Assistant Coach Position Description

ATHLETICS AT TBS: All athletics at TBS are co-ed and there are never any tryouts or cutting from teams. Teams are small enough where each student can feel that the coaches truly know their strengths and challenges and feel that they will receive the support they need and deserve to grow as athletes. The athletics program is centered around students having ample opportunities to participate through practices and games.

HOURS: This is a part-time position beginning January 7, 2020 and ending March 10, 2020. Weekly hours are Tuesdays and Thursdays 3:30 - 6:00p. As current CPR/First Aid certification is a condition of employment at TBS. Employees not certified by Friday, August 16, 2019 should expect to attend the CPR/First Aid certification course offered on campus on that day.

OVERVIEW OF POSITION: The role of the Middle School Basketball Assistant Coach is to support the Head Coach in fulfilling the program's goals. The Assistant Coach will attend all practices and games. All athletics at TBS are co-ed and there are never any tryouts or cutting from teams. Teams are small enough where each student can feel that the coaches truly know their strengths and challenges and feel that they will receive the support they need and deserve to grow as athletes. The athletics program is centered around students having ample opportunities to participate through practices and games. - Awareness of and experience working with diverse learning communities in equitable ways

- First Aid/CPR/AED certification required (course offered by The Berkeley School on August 16)
